- first line of a famous William Blake poem TYGER TYGER BURNING BRIGHT
- time signature referred to as common time FOUR FOUR
- Egyptian mother goddess ISIS
- Julie Andrews musical comedy VICTOR VICTORIA
- phrase preceding "read all about it" EXTRA EXTRA
- loose Hawaiian dress MUUMUU
- giant vehicles seen at the battle of Hoth AT-AT WALKERS
- home of Peter Pan and the Lost Boys NEVER NEVER LAND
- Konami rhythm game played with the feet DANCE DANCE REVOLUTION
- poet famous for writing with lower case letters ee cummings
- Jim Carrey film LIAR LIAR
- last half of Ring Around the Rosey ASHES ASHES WE ALL FALL DOWN (or A-TISHOO A-TISHOO etc)

Reading the first letters of this gives you the phrase POINT FIVE MANDELA, which is a punny way to clue HALF NELSON.
