This is based off the meme that you can read still comprehend English text if the first and last letters are fixed while the rest are permuted. If you attempt to do that, you'll find that exactly one word per sentence has an incorrect letter:

- wrrd: r  $\rightarrow$  o
- $\bullet \ esut: \ e \to j$
- ciodnatn<br/>ng: d $\rightarrow$ i
- plorabcy:  $\mathbf{c} \to \mathbf{b}$
- $\bullet \ oree: \ o \rightarrow w$
- $\bullet\,$ alt<br/>nlautenmitpe: l $\rightarrow$  e
- $\bullet \ degoinit: \ o \rightarrow l$
- $\bullet$  norrstr<br/>teehn: r $\rightarrow$ a
- l<br/>goeer:  $e \to n$
- msaesde: d  $\rightarrow$  g
- $\bullet$  trues fahs: f  $\rightarrow$  u
- rtehir: i  $\rightarrow$  a
- $\bullet$  a asrrend:  $s \to g$
- $\bullet~$  cetrhnocd: h  $\rightarrow$  e

The correct letters spell out the answer, OJIBWE LANGUAGE.
