- The ingredients in a Little Piston 2.0: **Tomato, mozzarella, basil pesto, sautéed mushrooms, and greens on a baguette** (Diesel Café)
- The largest recorded number of hot dogs eaten in 90 minutes at the Davis Square location: **17** (Spike's Junkyard Dogs)
- The year that Worcester Lunch Car #773 was established: **1941** (Rosebud Diner)
- The name of the art gallery to be found in the Somerville Theatre: **Museum of Bad Art**
- The square root of the post number of the hall named for a Medal of Honor recipient from WWI: **23** (George Dilboy Hall, VFW post 529)
- The fine for driving in an MBTA excluded way: **\$50** (sign at MBTA busway)
- The three words visible on the twin towers in the 9/11 memorial: **Service, Hope, Courage** (9/11 memorial added to the compass rose in the central intersection of Davis Square)
