



When in Rome

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This puzzle refers to Seven Hills Park, located behind the Holland St entrance to the T station. Seven Hills Park has columns for each of the seven hills of Somerville, each of which features the name of the hill, an informational plaque (two of which are missing), and an icon on top of the column. The icons on top of the columns match the icons in the puzzle; the letters S/W/L indicate the Sth sentence, Wth word, Lth letter of the informational plaque for that column.

Thus, the instructions translate to:

Take the name of the location with a (Prospect: FISH) on it: CLARENDON. (Ploughed: REMOVE) the (Prospect: FINAL) letter of the name of the location with a (Cobble: CONVENT) on it: CLARENON (Convent=Ploughed Hill). Move the (Spring: SIXTH) letter (Ploughed: ONE) space(s) back in the alphabet: CLAREMON Add the (Winter: FOURTH) letter of the name of the location with a (Spring: TREE) on it to the end of the string, and you're done: **CLAREMONT** (Tree=Winter Hill).

The answer is **CLAREMONT**.
