Collect the items below. Each item is worth 1 point unless explicitly stated otherwise. When you have compiled 16 points, with at least 4 points in each category, please call a BAPHL representative to have your findings verified.

Photographs

- A team member in front of a sign with the name of a primary color
- A person wearing a three-cornered hat (2 points)
- A team member swinging on a swing
- An illegally parked car
- A Zipcar, or a Zipcar space (bonus point for an illegally parked Zipcar, or a car illegally parked in a Zipcar space)
- A street sign indicating a square which is named after a person but is not Davis Square
- A team member in front of an establishment that has "square" in its name but not "Davis"
- A team member in front of a sign with a world capital on it
- A team member hugging a statue
- A team member trying and failing to hide behind an artistically painted switchbox

Physical Items

- A newspaper or magazine (bonus point if has a completed crossword puzzle)
- A cupcake (3 points; we may elect to keep it)
- A printed map that includes all or part of Davis Square, but was not part of a BAPHL handout
- A printed menu
- A printed concert schedule
