

## **Team-Building Exercise**

Teams were instructed to send a representative to the playground at Hodgkins Park, near the corner of Paulina St and Holland St. Once there, hunters were placed in groups of four, and given a box containing 32 slips of paper, half orange and half blue. The groups were told that these 32 slips of paper could be formed into 16 clues, two slips per clue, and that their task was to pair up the slips into clues and answer them. Some of the slips might reasonably be paired up in more than one way, but there was only one way to pair up all 32 slips. Whenever a group had successfully paired up a clue, and shown the pairing and its answer to the BAPHL representative, that group would get to send one person into the jungle gym, where 12 envelopes were hidden. That person could retrieve a slip of paper from one of the envelopes, and these slips of paper would be combined to form a clue for the final answer. Note that 16>12, so groups did not have to solve all of the paired clues to get all of the final clue; this was intentional. The 32 slips of paper the groups received at the beginning are shown on page 2; the 12 slips of paper they retrieved from the jungle gym are shown on page 3. A sheet for filling in the clue pairs and answers is shown on page 4.
