If the directions ask you a question, it means go straight (without crossing any streets) until you see an answer to the question.

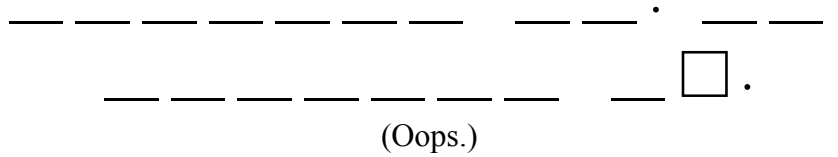

Cross straight twice. Turn toward the Google-colored signs. The juice bar here is for your



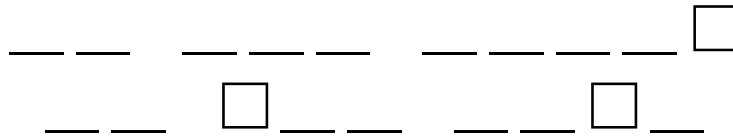

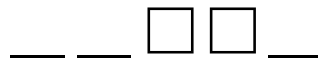
Stick with its first choice. The nice smiling lady wants you to have a _____ life:
